Hoag Health Center Irvine, which opened in September 2016, brings services and providers from the most sought-after health care institutes of Hoag to Irvine, including Hoag Women's Health Institute, Hoag Family Cancer Institute, Jeffrey M. Carlton Heart and Vascular Institute, and Pickup Family Neurosciences Institute. The project will now advance to the regional level where it will be judged against medical office buildings in the Pacific Southwest region.
