Hoag is an approximately \$1 billion nonprofit, regional health care delivery network in Orange County, California, that treats more than 25,000 inpatients and 369,000 outpatients annually. Hoag has been named one of the Best Regional Hospitals in the *U.S. News & World Report* Metro Edition, and *Becker's Hospital Review* named Hoag as one of the 2015 "100 Great Hospitals in America" – a designation Hoag has received three times.
