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Hoag Breast Center Named Certified Quality Breast Center of Excellence


Only Orange County Hospital Awarded for Dedication to Breast Health

"It's an honor to be one of 48 breast centers nationwide, and the only hospital locally, to be recognized as a Certified Quality Breast Center of Excellence," said <u>Allyson Brooks, M.D., the Ginny Ueberroth Executive Medical Director Endowed Chair of Hoag Women's Health Institute</u>. "This distinction reinforces Hoag's place as a national leader for breast cancer care and represents Hoag's commitment to providing the highest level of quality breast care to its patients."

Hoag was one of the first centers in the state to offer <u>Breast Tomosynthesis (3D Mammography)</u> and was one of 11 original beta sites for FDA approval for the technology. Hoag was the first hospital in Newport Beach to offer <u>breast MRI</u>. Additionally, under the direction of <u>Melvin Silverstein, M.D., Hoag Breast Center Medical Director and the Gross Family Foundation Endowed Chair in Oncoplastic Breast Surgery</u>, Hoag is one of the few elite programs nationwide to perform Oncoplastic Surgery.



"As the highest volume center in Orange County, Hoag Breast Center treats nearly 700 breast cancers annually and performs more than 40,000 screening mammograms a year. The quantity of Hoag's program is a testament to the quality of Hoag's individualized, comprehensive approach and its commitment to offering patients the latest advancements in screening, diagnostic and surgical technology," Dr. Brooks said.
