Hoag Named One of the Nation's 50 Top Cardiovascular Hospitals by IBM Watson Health

The <u>Watson Health 50 Top Cardiovascular Hospitals</u> study measures attainment in key performance areas: risk-adjusted inpatient mortality, risk-adjusted complications, percentage of coronary bypass patients with internal mammary artery use, 30-day mortality rates, 30-day readmission rates, severity-adjusted average length of stay, wage- and severity-adjusted average cost per case and, new this year, CMS 30-day episode payment measures. The study has been conducted annually since 1999.
